



## **GOLDEN PANDAS VOLUNTEER TRAINING COMPETITION**

### **1. Entrants**

- 1.1 All permanent residents of South Africa may enter.
- 1.2 Directors, members, partners, agents, consultants, tenants or employees of WWF-SA and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter this competition.
- 1.3 This competition will not be open to persons under the age of 18.

### **2. Term**

- 2.1 The competition shall be run from **Thursday 25 June 2020 from 12h00 to 13h00.**

### **3. The Prize**

- 3.1 The Prize is one adult grey melange WWF hoodie valued at R500.00 (five hundred rand).
- 3.2 The Prize **includes** postage to the entrant's given address, provided such address is in South Africa.
- 3.3 In the event that the Prize specified in the Competition becomes unavailable for any reason, WWF-SA may substitute a Prize of like or equal value.

### **4. Entries**

- 4.1 Entrants may enter and stand a chance to win the competition and must:
  - 4.1.1 Log on to the Golden Pandas Volunteer Training session taking place on 25 June 2020 starting at 12pm;
  - 4.1.2 Complete all details on the Zoom registration page to enter;
  - 4.1.3 Not share the Zoom link with any 3<sup>rd</sup> parties who have not registered as volunteers, in the event such 3<sup>rd</sup> party entry is drawn, it shall be forfeit.
- 4.2 WWF-SA takes no responsibility for any inability of an entrant to enter, complete, continue or conclude the competition due to equipment or technical malfunction, busy lines, inadvertent disconnection or otherwise.
- 4.3 By entering this competition the entrant accepts the full terms, conditions and rules of this competition and agrees to abide by these rules and any requirements and/or proceedings issued by WWF-SA in regard to the competition.

### **5. The Winner**

- 5.1 The Prize will be awarded to the first entrant drawn at random (witnessed by an independent auditor, attorney or advocate), by **WWF-SA** and the Winner will be notified by WWF-SA after the end of the training session that they are the winner of

the of the Prize draw. If the contact details provided by the entrant is not valid, he/she will forfeit the Prize, and another winner will be selected on the same basis.

- 5.2 The results of the competition will be verified by an independent auditor selected by WWF-SA.
- 5.3 The Winner accepts the Prize entirely at his/her own risk and indemnifies WWF-SA in respect of any claim for any accident, injury, or property damage that may occur in connection with the Prize to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 5.4 The Prize is exclusively for the Winner and is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash or another Prize, and must be accepted by the Winner within **one month** of winning the Prize or he/she will forfeit the Prize.
- 5.5 The Winner may be requested to be photographed and interviewed by the promoters and have his/her name published in promoter correspondence.
- 5.6 Where a diligent attempt to contact the Winner fails or the winner elects not to take the Prize or is unable to take the Prize for whatever reason WWF-SA reserves the right to either select another Winner or not award a Prize at all, in its sole discretion.
- 5.7 If, after successful notification, the Prize is not collected or receipt is not taken within one month of being announced it will be regarded as forfeit.

## **6. The Promoter**

- 6.1 WWF-SA reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of an entry and to refuse the entry of any person who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions or who tampers with any process in redeeming the Prize.
